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## Policies and Information

### Information:

Cobbler is defined as “a dessert made of cooked fruit covered with a thick crust”.

-Merriam Webster

The cobblers will be evaluated by judges and by popular vote from the public.  
Winning categories will be: Best Cobbler Overall, Most Creative, and People’s Choice.

Each team entry will be identified by a number. The judges and the public will sample all the cobbler and then vote accordingly. Winners will be awarded with a Blue Ribbon, a prize and bragging rights for the best cobbler in Roane County.

Judges will view cobbler intact and then taste samples.

The cobbler will be sampled in 2 oz containers, sample containers will be provided.

Tickets to the public will be sold for \$5.00 at the event.

### Rules:

1. Participants need to arrive at 3:00 pm
2. Cobblers need to be in a 13x9x2 inch disposable pan
3. Participants need to make at least 4 cobblers
  - a. There needs to be 12 quarts of cobbler, roughly 190 (2 oz) servings
  - b. This will be used for the popular vote
4. No refrigerated type cobblers will be accepted
5. Gloves must be worn when serving the food (gloves will be provided)
6. Participants must bring their own serving utensils
7. Containers holding the cobbler must remain covered when not serving
8. Keep station clean during competition
9. Participants will be responsible for marking tickets of those coming to sample their cobbler
  - a. Samples are not to be given without a valid ticket
